Dance City uses Google Classrooms on a regular basis to share important information to help you stay connected with the studio and your child such as photos, videos, themes, events, classroom activities and more! An email will be sent out shortly with all the details relating to signing up for your dancer's Google Classroom. We encourage everyone to sign-up to take full advantage of everything it has to offer!

### **Attire, Snack & Materials Policy**

Please label all items and belongings brought to the studio with your child's name.

Children need to wear a *comfortable outfit* that will allow them to move around. We ask that you please send your child with an extra set of clothes packed in their bookbag to every class – spills and accidents do happen. All students are required to have clean, non-marking indoor shoes such as runners.

Children will be taken to the bathroom for routine potty breaks if they are potty trained or actively working towards this goal at home. If your child has a noticeably dirty diaper, we will change it. If your child is not fully potty trained, please leave an extra pull-up (with





your child's name on it) in your child's bookbag. We kindly ask that all parents take their child to the bathroom before class to set them up for success.

Please pack along a *nut-free snack(s)* and a water bottle for your child to enjoy during snack time (reusable drink containers with water or juice are preferred). One to three types of finger foods are best; teachers will help open up containers, but children need to be able to feed themselves during their 10-minute snack time.

### **Drop Off & Pick Up**

Please stay with your child until class begins. Studio rooms will be opened approximately five minutes before class starts – we cannot take children prior to this, as the educators are setting up for the day. Dance City is not responsible for children before/after their class, and we kindly ask that your children are picked up in a timely fashion after their class ends and that you phone our office at 306-757-6495 if you're running late. If someone else will be picking your child up, please notify the teacher at drop-off. A parent must be available via cell phone in case we need to have your child picked up for any reason.

### **Photos, Waivers & Videos**

We will be taking pictures throughout the year to celebrate your child's learning and growth. Dance City holds the right to take videos and photos throughout the year, which may be used on our private Google Classroom, social media, in-house printed and promotional materials. Please refer to the registration contract for more information.

**New for the 2022-23 season!** We'll be running picture days for our Fine Arts Academy students in class on October 18, 20 and 23! More details will be provided closer to these dates, but we'll be sure to capture amazing memories for you to cherish for years to come. Stay tuned!





# **Integration Policy**

Our goal is to ensure your child feels safe, confident and inspired and we have outlined our integration policy below.

**First class**: Parents are invited to attend the first 30-40 minutes of class. If your child has siblings, they are more than welcome to attend as well. Children feed off their parent's energy – when the parent is relaxed, the child is more likely to be relaxed. Teachers will lead a 15 to 30 minute welcome orientation and connect with the parents and collect all personal profiles. This is your opportunity to get to know the teachers and connect with them. After the orientation is complete, parents will be kindly asked to leave, and children will explore and interact with one another. The goal is to set your child up for success and build trust and confidence.

**Second class**: Parents are welcome to come in the room for the first 15 minutes to help their child settle. After 15 minutes we kindly ask that all parents say goodbye to their child and leave the studio. This will allow us to build trust with your child.

**Third class**: Parents are welcome to bring the child into the classroom and have free play with their child for 5 minutes.

**Fourth class**: Parents say goodbye in the lobby area and teachers bring the students back into the room. If your child cries, it is best to leave them with us so we can redirect and build rapport with them. If your child is still unsettled after 30 minutes, we will call you and provide you with an update. At this time, we can come up with a suitable plan.

# Tips for Saying Good-Bye to Your Child: Explain, Assure & Love

- 1. Explain that you are going away and that you will come back
- 2. Assure them that you love them and that they will have fun
- 3. Give them a hug, say goodbye and proceed to leave short goodbyes are best





### **Learning Objectives & Themes**

Students will enjoy a different theme each week providing academic curriculum to assist with their learning. The goal of the program is to enhance your child's overall development including gross and fine motor skills and improve social, cognitive and emotional awareness. We use an integrated approach to learning and incorporate theme-based lesson plans so students get to feel it in their bodies so they can remember it in their minds. When discipline is required, our teachers use a positive redirection approach and encourage the children to make good choices. When children choose not to participate in the planned activities, they are instructed to observe the class so they are not a distraction to the other students and can still learn in the process.

Please note that we assess all our students during the first few weeks and may make recommendations to transfer to mini, little or kinder levels if appropriate. If there is a teacher recommendation that your child is not ready for our program, we will recommend that you join us at a later date and will provide you with a credit.

# **Shows & Family Celebrations**

Parents are invited to come and watch our mini showcases regularly throughout the year, followed by a wrap-up party with snacks. Families will be asked to contribute an item for this potluck style celebration (if permitted with current COVID-19 restrictions). The celebration show and party will occur the last hour of their scheduled class.

### **Teaching Team**

We are thrilled to have such well-rounded and experienced teachers leading this program that are passionate about children and will inspire them through the fine arts.



The coordinator of our Fine Arts Academy is Miss Randi. Miss Randi holds her Studio Fine Arts Club – High Impact Teacher Certification – Level 1 in Early Childhood Fundamentals, is a registered teacher with the Royal Academy of Dance, holds her ADAPT Teacher Certificates in Jazz and Tap, is a Licentiate Member of the CDTA Sask. Branch in Tap, holds her Acrobatic Arts Teacher Certification, and is a certified teacher of the AcroDance Pre-School program. She holds her Bachelor of Arts Education from the University of Regina. She has over 15 years of experience preparing and entering students for dance examinations and competitions and has been the recipient of numerous choreography awards.



Your child's educator for Fine Arts Academy on Tuesdays is Miss Rae. Miss Rae obtained a Bachelor of Education Degree and a Bachelor of Arts Degree majoring in Psychology from the University of Regina and holds her Studio Fine Arts Club – High Impact Teacher Certification - Level 1 in Early Childhood Fundamentals. She has been a dancer since she could walk and has trained in tap, jazz, ballet, acrobatics, hip-hop, and baton twirling. Growing up in the dance studio is where she fell in love with the arts. Rae holds her Advanced certificates in CDTA Tap and Jazz, Intermediate III Tap and Jazz ADAPT certificates, Grade 8 RAD certificate, and Advanced 1 RAD Ballet certificate. She was an assistant dance teacher for many years in Regina and later moved on to teach dance in Weyburn at the Drewitz School of Dance where she taught children of all ages. In Rae's classes, students are celebrated in a fun, positive, and safe environment. She brings a warm heart to every class as her dedication to education and the art of dance shines.







Your child's educator for Fine Arts Academy on Thursdays and Sundays is Miss Nicole. Miss Nicole is a registered teacher with the RAD, has her ADAPT Teachers certificate in Tap and Jazz, is an Licentiate Member with the CDTA SK Branch in Tap, and was a member of the Team Canada National Tap Team in 2014 that competed in Riesa, Germany. She completed her Advanced 2 RAD Ballet certificate, Grade 8 RAD Ballet certificate, Advanced CDTA Tap and Jazz certificates, Intermediate 1 ADAPT Tap and Jazz certificates and is a graduate of Dance City's Pre-Professional Program. She also has an absolute love for teaching children of all ages and has a particular soft spot for the little ones.

### **Referral Program**
